**Primary Team Declaration** - A player may register to play on more than one team at the same time during the seasonal year provided the teams are different ages or genders. If the player submits a registration form simultaneously for more than one team, then at the time of registration, the player must declare which team will be their primary team. In situations where a player submits a registration for one team and later joins another team, the first team is automatically the primary team.
